Vocabulary:

- 'em - (US) abbreviated "them"
- **not likely** - probably not
- **wanna** - (US) abbreviated "want to"
- **mind** - brain; way of thinking
- **Come on** - expression of encouragement meaning "come here, it's OK, it's safe"
- **no matter what** - do something (often to help) without any hesitation or reservations
- **hope** - a feeling of expectation and desire for a particular thing to happen
- **stand up together** - join forces in defense of a principle or against a violent attack
- **Jedi** - Jedi, Jedi Knights, or collectively the Jedi Order are the main heroic protagonists of many works of the Star Wars franchise. Working symbiotically alongside the Old Galactic Republic and later the Rebel Alliance, the Jedi Order is depicted as a monastic, academic, martial, and meritocratic peacekeeping organization whose origin dates back thousands of years before the events of the first film in the franchise.
- **buckle up** - fasten your seatbelt
- **bind** - cause (people) to feel united
